**21 concepts of the Kingdom of God  
for use in the curriculum of any subject**

<b>1. UNCONDITIONAL LOVE</b>	God loves me whatever I do: I can love God. (Exodus 34:6-7; John 3:16; 1 John 3:1)
<b>2. GREAT COMMISSION</b>	We can tell others about God's love. We can share God's love and kindness with people in our neighbourhood and with people in other countries. (Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:8)
<b>3. UNIQUENESS</b>	Father God has made each of us very special. (Genesis 1:27-28; 1 Peter 1:18-19)
<b>4. CREATOR AND CREATION</b>	Father God has made a wonderful world. (Genesis 1:1; John 1:1)
<b>5. PROTECTION/ SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD</b>	God is good and He is very strong. His plans are always the best. Bad things happen, but God/ good always wins in the end. We can trust Father God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit to look after us. (Ps. 33:6-11; Job 42:2; Romans 8:28; Ps.121)
<b>6. FATHERHOOD AND FAMILY</b>	God is a good father: we are all His family./ He wants all of us in His family.. (Ephesians 3:14-15; Genesis 1:27-28)
<b>7. UNITY AND DIVERSITY</b>	We (or they) are all different, and yet we (or they) all belong in the same family. We can play and work as a team if we each play our part. (1 Corinthians 12; Romans 12:3-8)
<b>8. STEWARDSHIP AND SERVANTHOOD</b>	We can help each other and take care of our things. This blesses other people. (Genesis 1:26; Luke 19:11-27; John 13:2-17; Philippians 2)
<b>9. ORDER</b>	God works in an orderly way. He wants us to do the same. Each number and letter has a place to be and so do we. (Genesis 1; 1 Corinthians 14:33,40; Isaiah 9:7a)
<b>10. RIGHTEOUSNESS</b>	We can learn what is right and what is wrong. (Psalm 89:14; Psalm 119:137; Isaiah 9:7; Romans 14:17)
<b>11. JUSTICE</b>	God always does what is right. He wants us to be like Him. (2 Chronicles 12:6; Psalm 89:14; Revelation 19:1-2)
<b>12. PROVISION AND RESOURCES</b>	Father God gives us what we need, and even more! (Genesis 22:14; Psalm 104; 1 Timothy 6:17)

<p><b>13.</b> <b>COMMUNICATION</b></p>	<p>God has made us able to speak and write, sing and dance, draw and paint, and listen to others too. By you always telling me the truth, I get to know you more and I can trust you more. (John 1:1-14; Ephesians 4:15; 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 1:1-2; 1 John 1:3,7)</p>
<p><b>14.</b> <b>WISDOM</b></p>	<p>God can help us make good choices. (Proverbs 2:1-4; 4:7-8, Colossians 2:2-3)</p>
<p><b>15.</b> <b>WONDER - WORSHIP</b></p>	<p>Father God loves us to sing to Him. Wow! God made that! God did that! There are so many beautiful and marvellous things in God's world! (Psalm 8; Job chapters 37-42; Daniel 4:3; Romans 11:35-36)</p>
<p><b>16.</b> <b>INTERDEPENDENCE</b></p>	<p>We need each other. This is true of everything in God's world. (Ecclesiastes 4:9-12; Galatians 6:2; 1 Corinthians 12)</p>
<p><b>17.</b> <b>HOME/PLACEMENT</b></p>	<p>God wants us all to have a place to live in and feel at home. Everything in the classroom has a proper place to be. (Acts 17:26; Ps.104)</p>
<p><b>18.</b> <b>GROWTH – MATURITY – FRUITFULNESS</b></p>	<p>God designed every living thing to grow big and make seeds/ have babies/ bear fruit. (Psalm 1:3; Psalm 92:12-15; Matthew 13:1-9,23; John 15:5; Ephesians 4:15-16)</p>
<p><b>19.</b> <b>GOVERNING – RULING</b></p>	<p>God has given us people whom we can see who are in charge of us, e.g. mum and dad, the teacher. He wants us to obey them and work with them. This brings peace. (Genesis 1:28; Matthew 28:18-20; Romans 13:1-5; Ephesians 6:1-2; Hebrews 13:17)</p>
<p><b>20.</b> <b>FORGIVENESS – RECONCILIATION</b></p>	<p>When things go wrong we can fix our friendships by saying 'sorry' and 'I forgive you'. This brings peace and sets us free. (Exodus 34:6; Matthew 18:21-35; Ephesians 2:13-16)</p>
<p><b>21.</b> <b>ETERNITY - INFINITY</b></p>	<p>We can live forever with Jesus and Father God. (Psalm 90:1-4; Ecclesiastes 3:11; John 17:3; 2 Timothy 1-10)</p>
