

Truth to Teach: The water cycle reveals God's wise and economic provision. Ecc.1:7

Learning Wisdom for Life: Re-cycling can be a wise procedure to conserve resources. God often uses a cycle process in creation.

Subject	Topic
Science	Moving Air

Truth to Teach: God created air to move; it reflects the spirit of God. John 3:8

Learning Wisdom for Life: The Holy Spirit is like the wind and we cannot control it; it moves where it will.

Subject	Topic
Maths	Fractions

Truth to Teach: Fractions demonstrate a numerical way of showing that everything in God's creation is part of something larger and can be separated into smaller parts in God's design.

Academic: fraction families and notation.

Learning Wisdom for Life: We are at once a whole person and also a fraction or part of a family, community or nation.

e.g. 1 Corinthians 12:27

Geography	Landscapes

Truth to Teach: God displays his power and might through the Creation of fold mountains, his creation causes us to wonder and worship.

Learning Wisdom for Life: Students understand the process by which God forms "fold" mountains and worship the awesome power of the Creator.

Truth to Teach: The Father multiplies, it is in his nature to multiply things because he is generous and desires to fill all things.

Learning Wisdom for Life: How can I like God, multiply his grace and love into the lives of other people?

Biology	Breathing

Truth to Teach: God's good creation in a fallen world can go wrong. He has given us ways to correct these effects, and can help us respond with compassion.

Learning Wisdom for Life: Identify the detail of God's creation, and that understanding can help us help others when things go wrong.

studies	equality

Truth to Teach: Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No man comes to the Father but by me."

Learning Wisdom for Life: pupils should be able to discuss how Christianity is unique among other religions, drawing from what they have learnt and experienced in their Christian lives.
