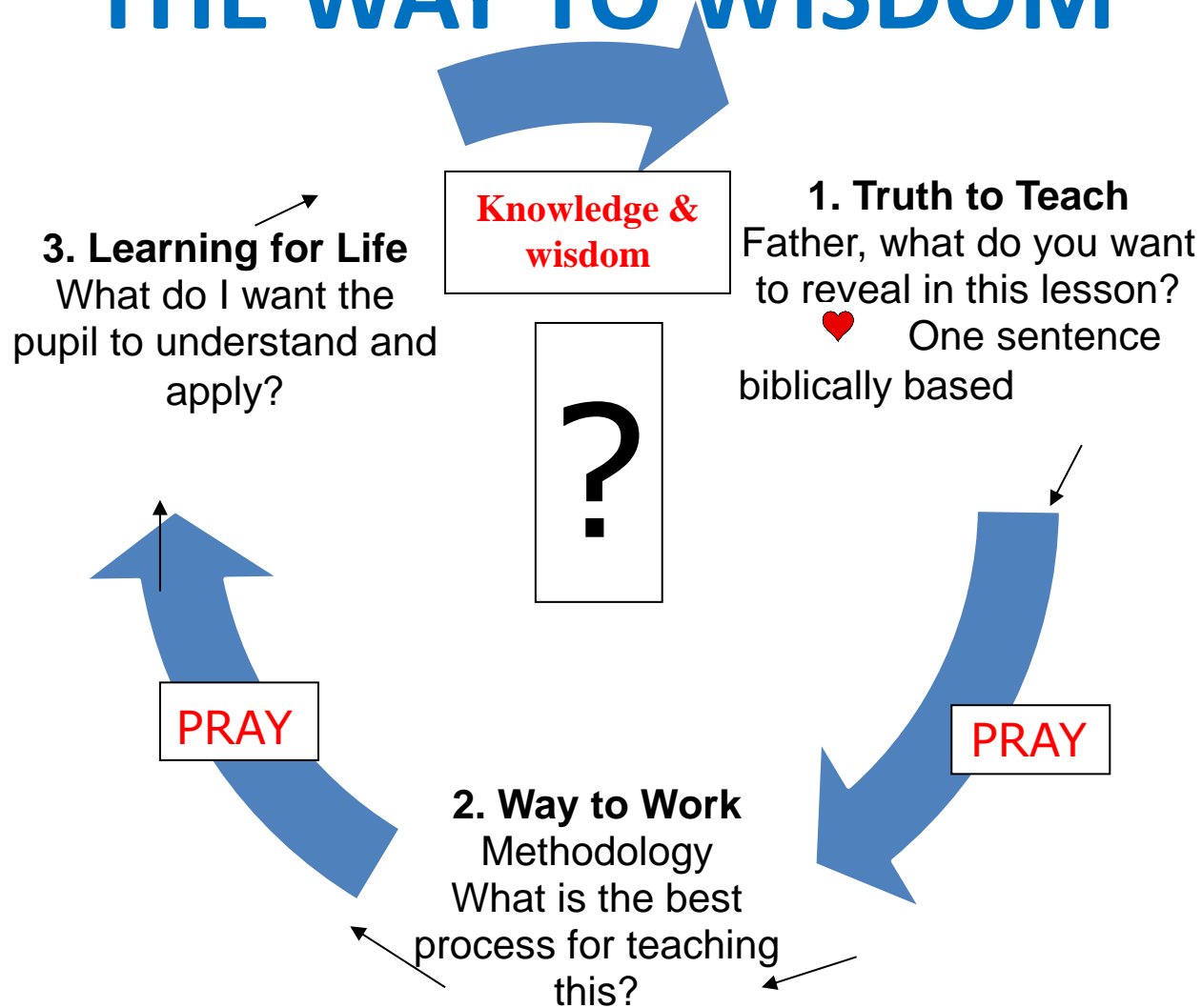

	Geography	Water Cycle
<p><b>Truth to Teach:</b> The water cycle reveals God's wise and economic provision. Ecc.1:7</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> Re-cycling can be a wise procedure to conserve resources. God often uses a cycle process in creation.</p>		

	Subject	Topic
	Science	Moving Air
<p><b>Truth to Teach:</b> God created air to move; it reflects the spirit of God. John 3:8</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> The Holy Spirit is like the wind and we cannot control it; it moves where it will.</p>		

	Subject	Topic
	Maths	Fractions
<p><b>Truth to Teach:</b> Fractions demonstrate a numerical way of showing that everything in God's creation is part of something larger and can be separated into smaller parts in God's design.</p> <p>Academic: fraction families and notation.</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> We are at once a whole person and also a fraction or part of a family, community or nation.</p> <p>e.g. 1 Corinthians 12:27</p>

	Geography	Landscapes
<p><b>Truth to Teach:</b> God displays his power and might through the Creation of fold mountains, his creation causes us to wonder and worship.</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> Students understand the process by which God forms "fold" mountains and worship the awesome power of the Creator.</p>

	Maths	Multiplication
<p><b>Truth to Teach:</b> The Father multiplies, it is in his nature to multiply things because he is generous and desires to fill all things.</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> How can I like God, multiply his grace and love into the lives of other people?</p>

	Biology	Breathing

**Truth to Teach:** God's good creation in a fallen world can go wrong. He has given us ways to correct these effects, and can help us respond with compassion.

**Learning Wisdom for Life:** Identify the detail of God's creation, and that understanding can help us help others when things go wrong.

No man comes to the Father but by me."</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> pupils should be able to discuss how Christianity is unique among other religions, drawing from what they have learnt and experienced in their Christian lives.</p>

<p><b>Truth to Teach:</b> (Lesson 1) God's heart is for all mankind to know him as Lord and Saviour. John3;16</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> Even when things go wrong God can still redeem.</p> <p><b>Truth to Teach:</b> (Lesson 2) Satan's desire is to control by dividing</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> God is sovereign but there are choices to be made in my life, in nations</p>

<p><b>Truth to Teach:</b> God speaks to us through written and spoken words. He converses with his servants (Exodus 33:11) words written in speech marks should be accurate and a truthful record of the actual words spoken and express the thoughts of the speaker.</p> <p><b>Learning Wisdom for Life:</b> Know when to use speech marks for an accurate report of words spoken.</p>
